



Virtually everyone has loose change lying about at home!

Coins can be found in bottles, in piggy banks, in drawers, under couch cushions, in the car, in pockets and in countless other places. **This tends to be forgotten money that is hardly ever used.**

These bright, colorful wraps help to round up loose change and put it to good use. There are many Stock Designs which may be ordered with or without a Custom Imprint on the front. A Custom Imprint may also appear on the back by way of a coupon or other special information.

Each MoneyWrap sheet comes as a set of 4, perforated for easy separation, comprising one wrap each of Pennies, Nickels, Dimes and Quarters. When all four are filled this totals \$17.50. The wraps assemble easily by folding on the score lines and adhering closed with our unique Peelit-'n-Sealit™ pressure sensitive adhesive to form tubes for different coin diameters.

# fundraising

Any non-profit organization, school, church, or other group in need of funds can use these wraps to bring in large sums of money quickly...

- 1 Participants round up loose coins from around the house and also collect pocket change from family, neighbors and friends.
- 2 They fill up one roll each of Pennies, Nickels, Dimes and Quarters, totalling \$17.50.
- 3 The rolls of coins are then brought to their organization as a set of 4. Ask the Participants write their names on each wrap.
- 4 Alternatively, the Participant can write a check and mail it to their Organization, (rolling up their coins after the donation is made.)

**quick results:** below are examples of money that can be raised in about 1 week!

**300 children** at a day-camp each fill a set of 4 coin wrappers. At a total of \$17.50 per child with 70% returned, this can raise about **\$3,700.00.**

**500 families** at a Church each taking 2 sets returning 80% could raise about **\$14,000.00.**

**120 seniors** at a bingo hall each filling a set of wraps returning 75% could raise about **\$1,600.00.**

Making any Campaign more successful with a prize incentive:

Turn the back of the wrap into an entry form. When volunteers turn in their rolled coins, this ticket can be submitted for a prize drawing. Prizes can be sponsored, and the sponsor's name can be printed on the header. The cooler the prize, the more rolled coin sets will be returned.
